Yes, this license allows you to modify, remix and re-distribute the work, so long as the derivative works are also shared under the same license.
Attribution-NoDerivatives (CC By-ND) 	Important if you want to make your work easily available or referenced.	Yes, every time the work is used, you have to give the author due credit.	Both commercial and non-commercial use	None, so long as you attribute its fine.	No! A work carrying the Attribution-No Derivatives license is only available for re-distribution.
Attribution-NonCommercial (CC By -NC) 	Useful to ensure that your work is put to non-commercial use only.	Yes, once again it is necessary to credit the author of the work.	Only non-commercial use	The terms of the licensing can be different so long as there is attribution and its for non-commercial use.	Yes, this license allows you to modify, distribute, remix the work into a new work, only so long as its for a non-commercial purpose.

Attribution-NonCommercial-Share Alike (CC BY NC-SA) 	Can be used to keep your work open, but at the same time, strictly non-profit.	Yes, crediting the author is very important.	Only non-commercial use	The license of the new work has to also be an Attribution-NonCommercial-Share Alike license.	Yes, this license allows you to modify, remix and re-distribute the work, so long as the derivative works are also shared under the same license terms and for non-commercial purposes.
Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives (CC BY NC-ND) 	Most restrictive of the licenses and meant for authors who want their work to be downloaded or redistributed for non-commercial uses.	Yes, it is highly important to credit the author when sharing their work.	Only non-commercial use	None, attribution and non-commercial purpose is all that is needed.	No! A work carrying this license is only available for re-distribution for non-commercial uses.
